
WILD BOOK TALKS

Anna Turns is an Oxford University biology graduate and journalist specialising in sustainability issues. She writes regularly for The Guardian, Wicked Leeks and many other publications.

Anna investigated the synthetic chemicals in her own body - from pesticides to flame retardants - how they got there and why it matters, which was broadcast as *My Toxic Cocktail* on BBC Radio 4's *Costing the Earth*.

In 2017 she founded her own environmental campaign, **Plastic Clever Salcombe**, which focuses on reducing single-use plastics and empowering children to make change.
