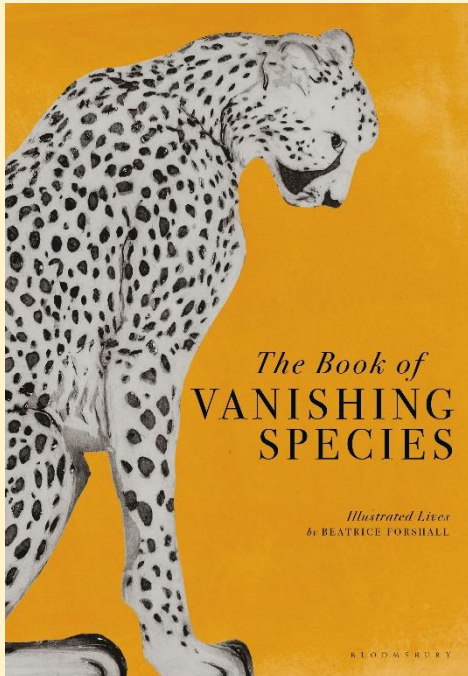


WILD BOOK TALKS

In 2018 she was artist in residence at the Cambridge Conservation Initiative (CCI), a pioneering collaboration between researchers, policymakers and practitioners focussed on transforming the global understanding and conservation of our natural world. *The Book of Vanishing Species* is her contribution to the cause.
