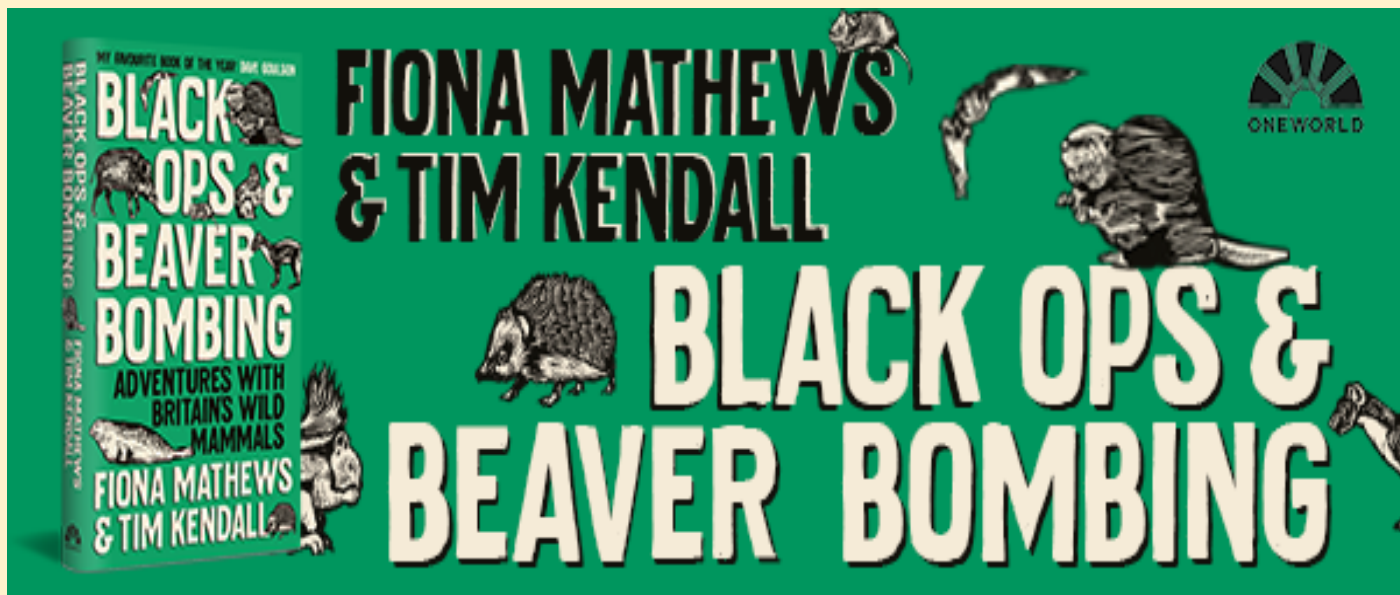


# WILD BOOK TALK
